The German Bundestag has invited artists to decorate the parliamentary buildings in Berlin with works of art designed specially for this purpose. You can see for yourself the impressive results of this Art and Architecture Programme, in which 111 artists were involved, on art and architecture tours.

REICHSTAG BUILDING

Saturdays, Sundays and bank holidays at 11.30 hrs; tour begins at the West portal of the Reichstag Building (left entrance, West A), or at the West portal, West C for disabled persons.

JAKOB KAISER BUILDING

Saturdays, Sundays and bank holidays, at 14.00 hrs and 16.00 hrs; tour begins at the North Entrance of the Reichstag Building, which has disabled access.

PAUL LÖBE BUILDING

Saturdays, Sundays and bank holidays, at 14.00 hrs and 16.00 hrs; tour begins at the North Entrance of the Reichstag Building, which has disabled access.

MARIE-ELISABETH LÜDERS BUILDING

Saturdays, Sundays and bank holidays, at 12.00 hrs and 14.00 hrs, beginning at the North Entrance of the Marie-Elisabeth Lüders Building, Adele-Schreiber-Krieger-Straße 1, which has disabled access.

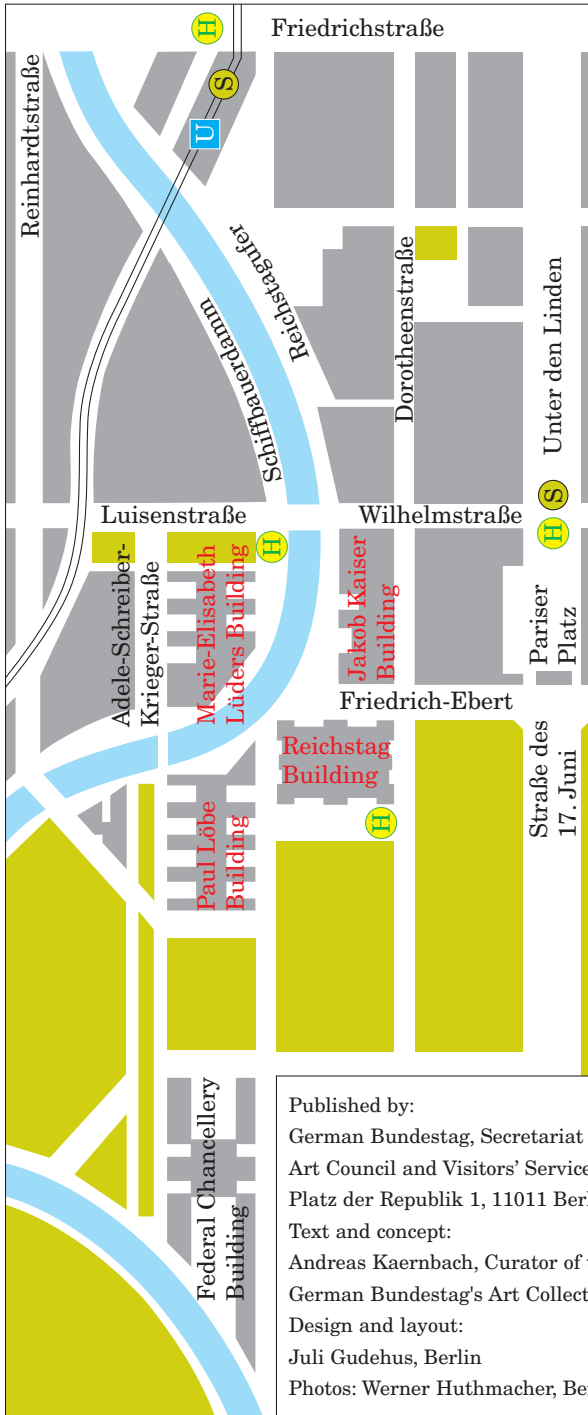
