

## Overview of Costs for the Reproduction of Archived Material

This overview of costs applies to the reproduction of archived material held in the Parliamentary Archives. It goes not apply to the reproduction of documents which are subject to the provisions of the Federal Act Governing Access to Information held by the Federal Government (Freedom of Information Act – IFG). The charges for reproduction of these latter documents are regulated by the Ordinance on Fees Payable under the Freedom of Information Act (Informationsgebührenverordnung – IFGGebV).

Approval is required for the reproduction of archived material, which is subject to the provisions of the Regulations on the Use of the Parliamentary Archives of the German Bundestag.

The user accepts the provisions of the Regulations on the Use of the Parliamentary Archives of the German Bundestag and, prior to use of the Archives, agrees in writing to be bound by them.
